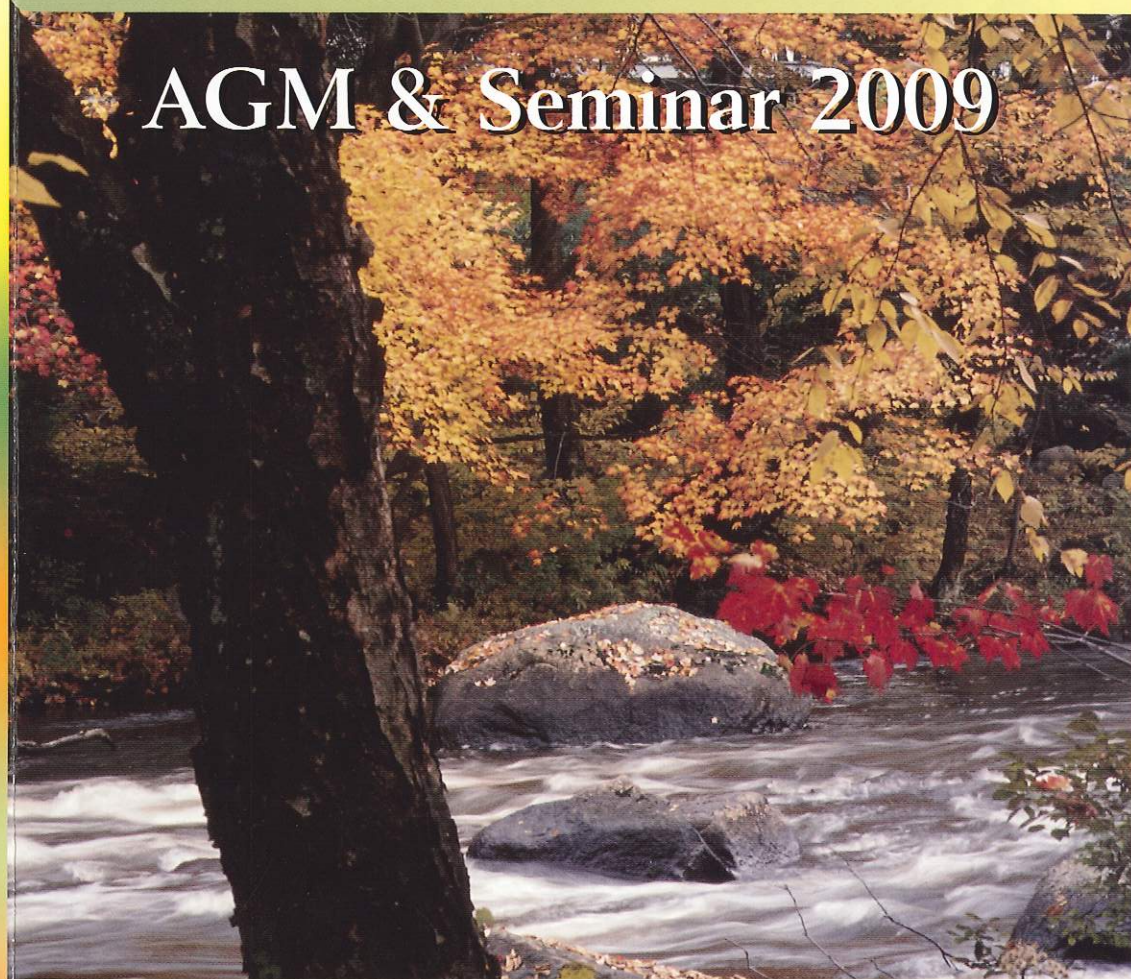

Torako Yui

Torako Yui was born in Ehime, Japan, in 1953. She worked for ten years for television production in Japan. This was followed by the next five years based in Britain as Japanese television news correspondent. When she developed ulcerative colitis she made a life-changing visit to a homeopath, which led to her being completely cured. She then changed her path and learnt classical homeopathy at the Regent's College in London. She transferred to the College of Practical Homoeopathy London (CPH) from the second year and graduated. She then passed a qualifying examination of the Homeopathic Medical Association (HMA) in Britain and became a professional registered homeopath.

In Britain she opened the Yui Homoeopathic Clinic and began practicing as a homeopath whilst studying for a two-year postgraduate degree at CPH. After accumulating a great deal of clinical experience, she started to practice in Japan as well where eventually she established a homeopathic college, the Japan Royal Academy of Homoeopathy (RAH), where she has been serving as the principal.

She has been officially recognised as the first Japanese homeopath and has been foremost in the promotion of homeopathy throughout Japan.

Her many achievements include:

- Principal of the Japan Royal Academy of Homoeopathy in Japan and in Britain
- President of the Japanese Homoeopathic Medical Association (JPHMA), founded 1998
- Honorary member of the Homeopathic Medical Association (HMA) in Britain
- Member of the Alliance of Registered Homeopaths (ARH) in Britain
- Honorary doctorate degree in homeopathy from Pioneer University
- Doctorate degree in homeopathy from International Medical University (IMU) in Switzerland.

Dr Luc De Schepper, MD, PhD, DI Hom., CHom., Lic.Ac,

is considered one of the foremost contemporary Homeopaths and renowned international lecturers in Classical Homeopathy in the world. Dr Luc was born in Ghent, Belgium, and is fluent in four languages. He is a Medical Doctor in Europe and the United States and has had offices in New Jersey, and California in Santa Monica and San Diego and is currently in practice in Los Angeles. He has been in practice for 38 years treating people exclusively with Hahnemann's Advanced



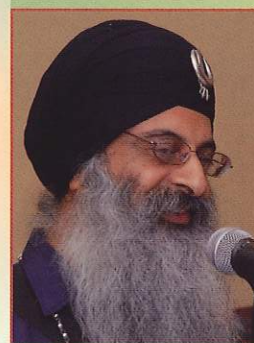
Methods according to the 5th and 6th edition of the Organon. He is also a licensed traditional Chinese Medicine physician (acupuncturist) in Europe and the United States. Dr Luc is the founder of the Renaissance Institute of Classical Homeopathy and the Mega Medical Group Inc, a wellness clinic in Santa Monica.

Dr Luc was one of the first 'integrated' Physicians as a Western medical doctor, acupuncturist and homeopath, integrating Western medicine and complementary medicine, and Acupuncture into Homeopathic practice. He became nationally known for his success in treating Candida and Chronic Fatigue with homeopathy, acupuncture, diet and supplements.

Dr Luc's lecture title is "Finding the Simillimum according to the Core Delusion formulated by Carl Jung".

Lecture 1: What is this Core Delusion and what is its importance? The patient will always hide what the homeopath needs the most: his most inner secrets, the ones that are most painful or shameful. Yet this dominant emotion will fit the simillimum while the chief complaint and additional info is only the mask, and therefore a simile, rather than the indicated remedy.

Lecture 2: How to find the Core Delusion: In the clinic and at your desk. In each patient case the homeopath should be able to find this Core Delusion. What are some of the criteria and tools to discover the Core Delusion?



Raj S Bains D.Hom., Med FHMA, M.R.Pharms

Raj Bains has practised homeopathy for 25 years and has lectured at colleges and conferences in the UK, USA, Canada, Japan and Saudi Arabia. Raj is an ex-student of Paul Shattock, director of the Autism Research Unit at Sunderland University, with whom he maintains close links.

He has always been interested in using various methodologies and has experimented much to determine the efficacy and practicality of different approaches ranging from ultra classical to field control therapy. His special interest has been the treatment of skin diseases such as eczema, psoriasis, acne, dermatitis, vitiligo, molluscum and warts. The treatment of skin diseases is often thought to be a difficult one amongst homeopathic circles. Raj Bains has treated hundreds of cases during his 25 years of practice. He will share his experience and give practical advice on dealing with these cases. Raj will show his methods of selection of the remedy with the help of slides of cured cases, and he will demonstrate how unlikely remedies such as Belladonna and Opium were found to be useful in treating chronic skin cases on totally unexpected and atypical symptoms of these remedies.
